Public notice: Yellow Fever prevention measures

Whereas Rwanda is Yellow Fever free, the Ministry of Health would like to inform you that the following measures have been adopted to protect travelers going outside or coming to Rwanda.

1. All travelers (citizens and non-citizens) coming to Rwanda must present a valid Yellow Fever vaccination certificate on arrival
2. All travelers (citizens) going outside Rwanda must obtain a Yellow Fever vaccination certificate
3. For travelers coming to Rwanda (citizens and non-citizens) without a valid Yellow Fever vaccination certificate will obtain one on arrival at Kigali International Airport upon payment of 40 USD or its equivalent in Rwandan francs (Frw).

Note: The Government of Rwanda requires proof of Yellow Fever vaccination for all travelers, except infants. This provision is with immediate effect
